### **Position: Training Assistant (Live Model) – Portable Ultrasound Training Course**

#### **About the Role**

We are seeking reliable and professional live models to support a specialized portable ultrasound training program for medical fellows. As a live model, you will serve as a surrogate patient, allowing trainees to practice hands-on ultrasound scanning techniques in a safe, controlled educational environment. This role is essential in helping trainees to develop competency in portable ultrasound imaging while maintaining the highest standards of patient safety and professional conduct.

#### **Key Responsibilities**

- Serve as a surrogate patient for ultrasound scanning practice in designated anatomical regions (e.g., cardiac, lung, abdominal)
- Maintain professional composure and reliability while being examined by multiple trainees and faculty instructors
- Attend scheduled training sessions punctually and comply with all course procedures and institutional policies
- Provide basic feedback on physical comfort during scanning (positioning, probe pressure, duration)
- Follow infection control protocols, including cooperation with probe cleaning and hygiene standards
- Adhere to privacy and confidentiality requirements throughout the course

#### **Essential Requirements**

- Age & Health: Generally healthy adult (18–65 years) with no significant unstable medical conditions
- Medical Screening: Must pass basic health screening and declare any contraindications (e.g., pregnancy, cardiopulmonary disease, skin conditions)
- Physical Fitness: Ability to tolerate repeated positioning changes and mild probe pressure for 3–4 hours, with scheduled breaks. Can cooperate with brief (~30 seconds) breath-holding during USG examination.
- Communication: Fluent in English or Cantonese (or both); ability to communicate comfort levels clearly

- Professional Standards: Reliable attendance, punctuality, and willingness to work in a mixed-gender clinical education setting
- Consent & Compliance: Willingness to provide informed written consent and comply with all course and institutional policies

**Desirable Qualifications**

- Prior experience as a surrogate patient or volunteer in medical education
  - Familiarity with healthcare or clinical environments
  - Calm demeanor and can stay comfortable with educational examination procedures
